System Enhancement - Shared Trades

Screen Dealing Bulletin 47/00 raised issues regarding the operation of the new shared order group functionality and the fact that shared order trades appeared in the Confirmed Trades window of all shared users. At that stage a request was made to change the functionality such that users would have the option to filter other users shared order trades in the Confirmed Trades window.

The SFE has recently received an update to this functionality from its developers. After successful testing, the SFE intends to commence implementation of this upgrade beginning the weekend of the 30 December 2000. The SFE has chosen to perform the upgrades to Participant workstations in a staggered approach so that Participants are not inconvenienced by having to provide weekend access to SFE technical staff. Some Participants will be upgraded remotely on this weekend with all other Participants being upgraded during the week commencing 2nd January 2001. SFE Technical Support will contact all SYCOM® managers during this week to arrange an appropriate time to perform the upgrade.

It should be noted that Participants MFWS' will continue to function as normal whether or not the upgrade has been performed. However once the SFE has commenced the upgrade at a Participant's site, then whilst this is being performed by SFE technical staff Participants should refrain from transferring or seizing orders.

The following illustrates how users can select or de-select the display of shared order trades from their confirmed trades' window:

1. Select Tools → Options → Trades.
2. Check/Uncheck 'Display Shared Trades'
3. Select 'Apply' and 'OK'

If checked, the user will receive all shared order trade confirmations for the corresponding groups in which they are allocated. If unchecked, the user will only receive trade confirmations for orders which they have ownership.
