ROUTER MAINTENANCE


Participants are advised that SFE will be performing routine maintenance to core router 2 after the close of trading on Saturday, 14 July 2001. Further, remote maintenance will be performed on a number of Participant routers. The maintenance is necessary to remove a workaround designed to prevent backup line failure. Following the upgrade to the CISCO operating system, this workaround is no longer required.

Please ensure that all routers are powered up over the weekend to assist successful software upload. Participant technical staff will be contacted by SFE prior to the weekend and also in the event of any problems experienced on Saturday, 14 July 2001.

The maintenance will begin after the SYCOM® system is brought down as per normal shut down procedures on Saturday morning. Trading and report generation will not be effected.

The maintenance will include the hardware replacement of a Versatile Interface Processor 2 card on core router 2 and the reconfiguration of the floating static router at a number of Participant sites.
