FOSTER'S BREWING GROUP LIMITED – CHANGE OF COMPANY NAME

1.0 Introduction

- 1.1 On 28th May 2001, Fosters Brewing Group Ltd (FBG) shareholders approved a proposed name change to **Fosters Group Ltd**.
- 1.2 The purpose of this Bulletin is to describe proposed adjustments to FBG Individual Share Futures contracts (commodity code 'FB') upon the name change becoming effective.
- 1.3 **Participants are advised to refer to further announcements by FBG in respect of the Effective Day of the proposed name change.**

2.0 Potential Changes

- 2.1 Upon the name change becoming effective, all existing FBG 'FB' series will be re-designated as Individual Share Futures contracts based on Fosters Group Ltd shares (ASX code 'FGL'). The commodity code and contract specifications for all FBG 'FB' series will remain unchanged.


3.0 Settlement & Delivery
