**TELSTRA CORPORATION LIMITED SPECIAL DIVIDEND – ACTION IN RESPECT OF
 TELSTRA CORPORATION LIMITED CASH SETTLED AND DELIVERABLE INDIVIDUAL
 SHARE FUTURES CONTRACTS**

1.0 Introduction

- 1.1 On 27 February 2003, Telstra Corporation Limited (TLS) announced their intention to pay a special dividend, amounting to 3 cents per share fully franked. The ex-dividend date for the special dividend is Monday, 17 March 2003.
- 1.2 As a consequence of the special dividend, the Exchange will adjust all existing Telstra Corporation Limited cash settled Individual Share Futures contracts (commodity code TE) with open interest and all existing Telstra Corporation Limited deliverable Individual Share Futures contracts (commodity code TA). **The Effective Date for these adjustments will be Monday, 17 March 2003.**

2.0 Contract Adjustments

- 2.1 To accurately reflect the payments made to holders of Telstra Corporation Limited shares, the Exchange will adopt a similar approach to the adjustment of TLS ISFs. This will occur as per the following formula:

$$\begin{aligned}
 \text{Debit/Credit per ISF open position} &= \text{Special Dividend} \times \text{number of Underlying Shares per} \\
 &\quad \text{TLS ISF} \\
 &= \$0.03 \times 1,000 \text{ shares} \\
 &= \$30.00
 \end{aligned}$$

All holders of TLS ISF positions (commodity codes TE and TA) at the close of business on Friday 14 March 2003 will therefore be affected in the following way;

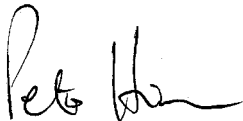
- 2.1.1 Long position holders will be **credited** with the value of the special dividend consistent with the formula above;

2.1.2 Short position holders will be **debited** with the value of the special dividend consistent with the formula above;
