

TENDER DOCUMENTATION (Cont'd)

(2) During the Delivery Period:

Tender documentation must be lodged on any business day within the delivery period prior to 12:30 pm, except on the final day of trading, when it must be lodged prior to 3:00 pm.

NB: During the actual delivery period, a Clearing member wishing to go to delivery, who has already obtained SAR(s) will only need to submit to the SFECH the SAR(s) accompanied by a Delivery Notification form.

- Individual Test Certificates underlying Combination Certificates (refer to SFE Circular No. 286/97)

Warehouse Receipt

All the documentation on the previous page must be **original** copies. No faxed - documentation will be accepted. Any Clearing Members attempting to submit copies other than the original documentation will be in default.

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GENERAL

All Clearing Members with short and/or long positions must lodge with SFECH an Ending Position Confirmation document everyday during the delivery period. The Ending Position Confirmation must be lodged with SFECH by no later than 5:30pm every day during the delivery period except on the last business day when it must be lodged by no later than 1:30pm. Clearing Members with short positions must also lodge a Tender Information Summary and Delivery Notification on the day that they require a delivery to take place. These forms must be lodged with SFECH by no later than 12:30pm on any day during the delivery period except for the last business day, where they must be lodged by no later than 3:00pm.

The next contract delivery date is **Thursday 15 June**.

As in previous contracts there is a five day delivery period.

Specific SFE appraisal is not required by the Australian Wool Exchange (AWEX) to issue an Appraisal Certificate.

Certification can be obtained based on the AWEX audit report of broker appraisals. Reports listing the sale lots traded through the AWEX auction system that are deemed eligible for SFE delivery are available by subscription from AWEX.

The Australian Wool Exchange must receive the *'Request for Issue of an Appraisal Certificate for Wool'* by the dates listed below. These requests should be sent directly to the Registrar.

Western Region: Samples to be presented for appraisal in Fremantle.
