## **SFE / OMX SECUR BUSINESS CONTINUITY TEST**

Participants are advised that in accordance with SFE's obligations under the Financial Stability Standards (FSS) to test the technical redundancy of its clearing infrastructure, SFE with the assistance of OMX will be utilising the SECUR technical facilities for the clearing of the derivative market from its Disaster Recovery Site (DRS) on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> February 2005.

The provision of SECUR clearing services from the SFE / OMX DRS will not require any intervention from Participants and should have no impact on Participants performing their normal business activities. The SECUR system will be returned to its normal configuration for the beginning of clearing activity on Monday 21<sup>st</sup> February 2005.

The transition from live production site to DRS has been fully technically tested. In addition recovery options in the event of a required rollback have been developed to minimise the risk of Participant impact and OMX Secur unavailability.
