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RESULTS OF SFE / OMX BUSINESS CONTINUITY TEST OF SECUR

Further to SFE Clearing Bulletin 04/05 issued on 14th February 2005 SFE are pleased to announce the successful completion of the Business Continuity (BC) capability test of its SECUR derivatives clearing system.

The test was performed utilizing the systems located at its BC site to process live production clearing activities during Friday 18 February, including overnight batch processes.

The BC systems were promoted to Primary prior to market opening on the Friday and reverted to normal configuration over the weekend.

Performance was monitored by SFE users and no performance degradation was observed by Participants.

SFE believes the embedded resilience within modern infrastructure and application architectures facilitates this approach. It demonstrates the Industry-Wide capability required of the FSS and removes the risks associated with test data corrupting the Production environment if such tests are performed outside of trading hours.

No problems were experienced or reported with the test and the systems commenced normal operation on Monday, 21 February.

SFE anticipates basing its BC testing programme on this approach wherever possible. However actual fail-over tests will continue to be performed out of hours.
