## AUSTRALIAN GOVERNMENT FINANCIAL SANCTIONS AGAINST ENTITIES ASSOCIATED WITH THE DEMOCRATIC PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF KOREA

The Reserve Bank of Australia (RBA) has requested that the following information be brought to the attention of Participants of Sydney Futures Exchange (SFE), SFE Clearing Corporation (SFECC) and Austraclear.

Following a directive from the Australian Government under the Banking (Foreign Exchange) Regulations 1959, the RBA currently administers financial sanctions against certain entities and an individual associated with the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, such that all transactions involving the transfer of funds or payments to, by the order of, or on behalf of such entities or persons are prohibited without the prior approval of the RBA.
