If ASX Market Access does not receive a completed Subscriber Technical Access Agreement and Order Form by 21 September 2009 your existing access to the ASX External Technical Environments will cease.

Subscribers are advised:

- No changes to the Subscriber Technical Access Agreement will be considered.
- Two original executed Subscriber Technical Access Agreements and Order Forms must be returned to Market Access via Mail.
- Subscriber Technical Access Agreements and Order Forms must be returned to Market Access by 21 September 2009 to continue existing arrangements.
