## ASX AUSTRACLEAR EXIGO BUSINESS CONTINUITY TEST

Participants are advised that in accordance with its obligations under the Financial Stability Standards (FSS) for Securities Settlement Facilities, Austraclear intends to test the technical redundancy of its infrastructure. To facilitate this Austraclear will be operating EXIGO from its Disaster Recovery Site (DRS) for the week commencing 9<sup>th</sup> November 2009.

The provision of EXIGO services from the DRS will not require any intervention from Participants and should have no impact on Participants performing their normal business activities. The EXIGO system will be returned to its normal configuration for business on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> November 2009.

The transition from live production site to DRS has been fully technically tested. In addition, recovery options in the event of a required rollback have been developed to minimise the risk of Participant impact and EXIGO unavailability.
