ASX AUSTRACLEAR SYSTEM GUI UPDATES

Participants were advised via Notice 187/09 that ASX Austraclear would be operating from its Disaster Recovery Site (DRS) on the week commencing 9 November, 2009. While Participants were able to connect to ASX Austraclear from the morning of the 9 November 2009, some Participants experienced delays to connectivity.

To ensure Participants' ability to connect to ASX Austraclear in a seamless manner, regardless of whether ASX Austraclear is operating from either its Primary or DRS, an updated GUI is required to be installed by each user.

Participants will need to download the most recent version of the GUI by **Monday 22 February 2010**.

Implementation Approach

The GUI will be made available to Participants on the ASX website from 11:00am (Sydney time), Saturday 20 February 2010.

ASX recommends essential users download and/or perform a test login on Saturday 20 February 2010. Support will be available from 11:00am – 2:00pm (Sydney time) on Saturday 20 February 2010.

Essential users may include Participant administrators, core business user(s) and their backup(s).

New Application version details are as follows:

- Austraclear System – version I48_v86-9.

File Deployment

Participant's who package the application, log into the EXIGO application by either selecting the desktop shortcut or launching EXIGO CSD via the Start menu.

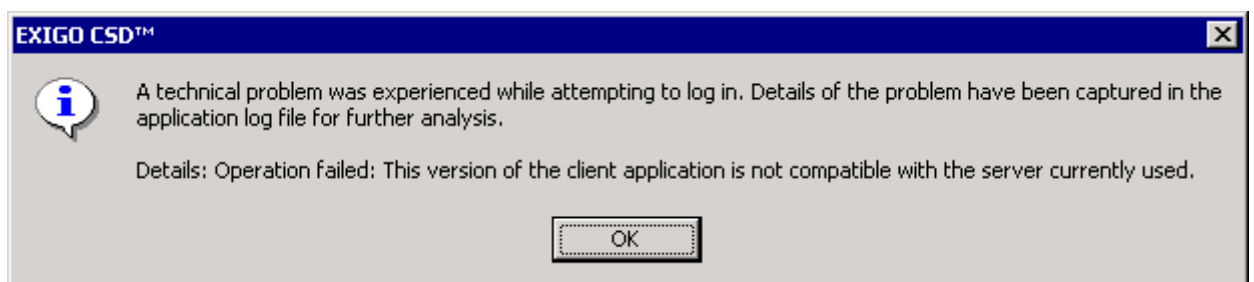
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For these Participants, the Austraclear System File Deployment version will be available for download and can be installed from Monday 15 February, 2010. MSI file and installation manuals will be available from:

www.sfe.com.au/content/austraclear/operations/exigo/technical.htm.

Note that the new File Deployment version does not become functional until Monday 22 February 2010. Austraclear recommends not removing the current File Deployment version (I.48_v86-8) in your machine, until a successful log on to the new version during go-live on the **22 February 2010** or during implementation on Saturday 20 February 2010 (between 11:00am and 2:00pm (Sydney time))

Please note that during implementation, users using an old file deployment version will be prompted with this message when they try to log in:

Browser Deployment

Participants who access the EXIGO application via their Internet browser will need to download a new GUI. The GUI will automatically download when the user selects the Production Environment option from Saturday 20 February 2010.

The GUI will be made available for download at any time after 11:00am (Sydney time) Saturday 20 February 2010. Not all users have to download on the same day. Participants only need to ensure essential users download the new version on the Saturday before go-live.

The file will be available for download from 11:00am* and support will be available until 2:00pm (Sydney time).

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This will avoid network traffic or download issues during the Monday go-live, where all of the participants using browser deployment are downloading the new version of the Austraclear System and logging into the application.

Austraclear also recommends that Participants using this deployment method have at least one backup of the current version (1.48_v86-8) before attempting to download the new version.


