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### **ASX AUSTRACLEAR SYSTEM GUI UPDATES**

Participants are advised that an updated version of the ASX Austraclear GUI will be available from Saturday 19 June 2010 for download by all Austraclear users.

The upgraded GUI provides enhancements to the report auto-download functionality within the system. Additional information on the upgrade can be found in the Austraclear New Fee Categories frequently asked questions (FAQ) section that is available on the ASX.com website.

Participants will need to download the upgraded GUI by Monday 21 June 2010.

#### **Implementation Approach**

The GUI will be made available to Participants on the ASX website from 11:00am (Sydney time), Saturday 19 June 2010.

ASX recommends essential users download and/or perform a test login on Saturday 19 June 2010. Austraclear support will be available between 11:00am and 2:00pm (Sydney time) on the day.

Essential users may include Participant administrators, core business user(s) and their backup(s).

#### **New Application version details are as follows:**

- Austraclear System – version I48\_v86-9p3

#### **File Deployment**

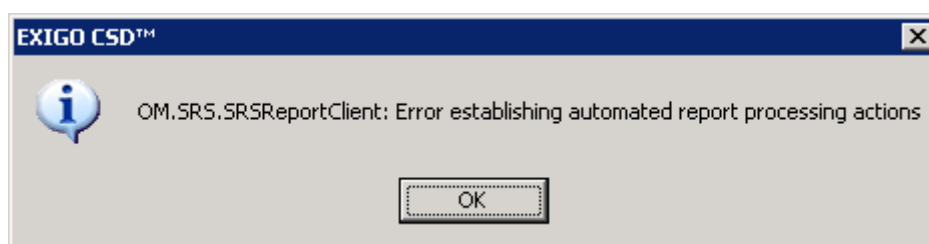
Participants who package the application need to log into the Austraclear System by either selecting the desktop shortcut or launching EXIGO CSD via the Start menu.

The Austraclear System File Deployment version will be available for download and can be installed from Tuesday 15 June, 2010. MSI file and installation manuals will be available from:

Note that the new File Deployment version does not become functional until Monday 21 June 2010. Austraclear recommends that Participants do not remove the current File Deployment version (I.48\_v86-9) until a successful log in to the new version is established during go-live on 21 June 2010 or during implementation on Saturday 19 June 2010 (between 11:00am and 2:00pm (Sydney time))

Please note that during implementation, users using an old File Deployment version will be prompted with the following message when they try to log in:



However, users will be able to continue to log in but will have no View Report functionality. A password will be required to gain access to the MSI file and this can be obtained by contacting Austraclear Help Desk on 1300 362 257.

## Browser Deployment

Participants who access the EXIGO application via their Internet browser will need to download a new GUI. The GUI will automatically download when the user selects the Production Environment option from Saturday 19 June 2010.

The GUI will be available for download from 11:00am (Sydney time) Saturday 19 June 2010. Not all users have to download on the same day, however essential users must download the new version on Saturday 19 June before go-live on Monday 21 June.

This will avoid network traffic or download issues on the Monday when all of the Participants using browser deployment are downloading the new version of the Austraclear System and logging into the application.

Austraclear also recommends that Participants using this deployment method have at least one backup of the current version (I.48\_v86-9) before attempting to download the new version.
